Deuteronomy 7:22 “And the Lord your God will clear out those nations before you, little by little; you may not consume them quickly, lest the beasts of the field increase among you.”

Just before they entered the Promised Land, the Lord told the Israelites that He would drive out their enemies before them “little by little,” lest the beasts of the field increase among them. I believe pride is one of the “beasts” that will consume us if we receive too much freedom too quickly, and the best way to gain lasting freedom and wholeness is to be liberated one area at a time. That way, we appreciate our freedom more; we realise it is truly a gift from God and not something we can make happen in our own strength.
