THE LORD WILL GUIDE YOU ALWAYS (see Isaiah 58:6-12)

As many of you know I am a pensioner with a paper round (oh, how I have reached the heights!). Last week I was faced with a dilemma. I have to put leaflets in the papers before I deliver them and I had a pile of leaflets advertising the services of a physic/medium/healer who was promising prayer, spiritual enlightenment, healing and the reaching of departed love ones. The opposite of Jesus and a gigantic con of Satan. I didn't want to put them in the papers so I said to myself, "I will leave them out," but then I thought, I can't do that because I am being paid to deliver them. Ok, I said, I will put one in every other paper, so then I thought that's just being economical with the truth, I am still cheating my employer. Well, I thought, if I ring the paper and say I can't deliver these, they may well say, "your belief and convictions are not our problem, just deliver them." Well yes, it's not like a major issue but I still don't want to do it, so what do I do God? Well this was His answer and I think it's simply brilliant. I prayed over the pile of leaflets (I am not crazy) and asked God to make them invisible to the people who received the papers.
