Thought for the Week – from Caroline

HE IS RISEN

RESURRECTION POWER

At one hundred pounds, Loretta's utility bill was much higher than usual. "But the Lord will provide," she told her son. That same day she received a text from her youngest brother: "Loretta, you're always encouraging me, and I want to thank you. Look out for something from me in the post." That afternoon, she received a gift card from her brother for £100. A miracle? Not to some, perhaps. To Loretta however, the coincidence felt miraculous. She always expects the living God to provide for her.

Her outlook highlights a lesson in the resurrection story of Jesus. After the Sabbath, three women brought spices to anoint Jesus's body in the tomb. But walking there after sunrise, the women expected not a miracle but a problem: "Who will roll the stone away from the entrance of the tomb?" (Mark 16:1-3) Embedded in their question was a curious doubt, especially from these women – including Mary Magdalene – who had travelled with Jesus and witnessed His power. All of them, however, were looking that morning for a dead Jesus.

Instead, "He is risen! He is not here!" they were told (v6). That declaration explains what we can expect from the living Jesus: His miraculous resurrection power. He is alive. When we face "heavy stones" that need moving, He will be with us and help us. He's not in a tomb. He is risen, indeed!
