Thought for the Week – from Caroline

Proverbs 24:16

For though the righteous fall seven times, they rise again, but the wicked stumble when calamity strikes.

We are going through a series of "My Story" and I can only speak about my own feelings of vulnerability when you "bear your soul" publicly. It's not easy and you think, "Should I actually share that? Is it appropriate? What will people think, will they see me differently, will they have empathy, compassion, understanding or will they just not 'get it?'" Well, I have come to the conclusion that if God wants you to say it, however shocking, say it, because God knows every detail of our lives and He wastes nothing. Whatever you've done, good, bad or ugly, He will use it for His purposes. If people judge you, so be it, God doesn't, so brush it off if they do. There will always be people who don't understand or are not ready to hear what you are saying, but equally there will be people so relieved to know that you've experienced similar pain and confusion or just been a selfish sinner and they feel guilty about that but will learn that they are forgiven and can move on.

People don't always want to hear about how good a Christian you are, they want to hear an honest account of your life with all its failures and weaknesses and how God has brought you through. We are all living in God's "repair shop" and some have needed more repair than others. We are sinners becoming saints and though we fall seven times (more in my case) we rise again.
