Thought for the Week – from Caroline

Proverbs 17:28 *Even fools are thought wise if they keep silent, and discerning if they hold their tongues.*

Even after all these years as a Christian I learnt a hard lesson the other day and realised I'm not as wise as I think I am. The trouble is I text before I think, and sometimes I should definitely pray before I text. I was passing on a message from one person to another, so I was the third party. But instead of editing the message to soften the blow I gave the full message which caused hurt. I was ridden with guilt and astonished at my own stupidity. I have heard people evangelise in such a way I cringe. It can be “over the top” and they are imparting Christian phraseology that even they don't fully understand. We also, in some cases, need to tread carefully. For example in my opinion, and I know because I've lived it, it's not helpful to start talking about forgiveness when somebody is seething with anger and bitterly hurt. It's been said “silent evangelism” is best used to build relationships and earn the trust required to share your faith verbally when the opportunity arises and this is what I try to do in many cases. Silent evangelism is showing them the values you hold dear and the life you lead.

When You Say Nothing At All

Its amazing how you can speak right to my heart
Without saying a word, you can light up the dark
Try as I may, I can never explain
What I hear when you don't say a thing

The smile on your face lets me know that you need me
